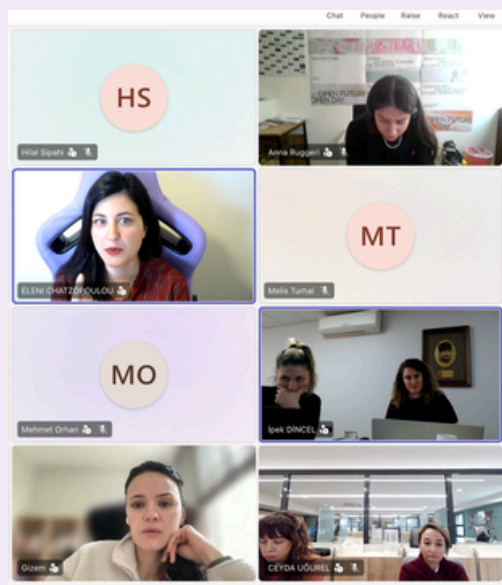
## WELCOME TO OUR 3rd Newsletter

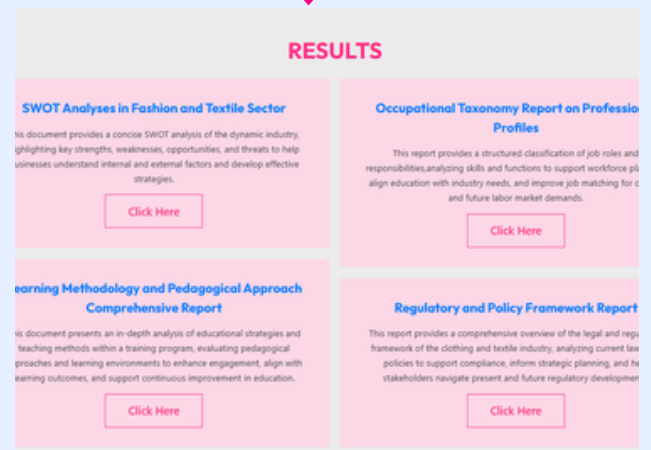


## REMODE TURKIYE PARTNERS MEETING

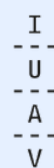

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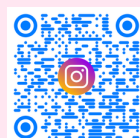
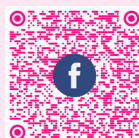
