

COVE REMODE UNLOCKING CIRCULAR FASHION DESIGN EXCELLENCE



Participation in the Athens Fashion Hackathon



Members of the Bursa Uludağ University (BUU) project team participated in the Athens Fashion Hackathon held between 10 and 14 November 2025, following an invitation from project partner Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB), which was also involved in organising the event within the framework of another EU-funded initiative. The REMODE project was presented during the hackathon under the overarching theme of sustainability, contributing to cross-project synergies and reinforcing the visibility of Erasmus+ Centres of Vocational Excellence initiatives.

The BUU representative took part in the event in multiple capacities, including mentor, expert and invited speaker. In these roles, support was provided to participating teams through mentoring activities, and an expert presentation was delivered focusing on sustainability-related challenges, systemic constraints and solution pathways within the textile and fashion ecosystem. The presentation highlighted the objectives and approach of the REMODE project, particularly its focus on circularity, digitalisation and skills development.

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The hackathon also enabled extensive networking and exchange of knowledge with entrepreneurs, fashion designers, textile engineers and startup representatives from several European countries, including the Netherlands, Italy, France and Greece. These interactions supported the project's dissemination and impact objectives by fostering dialogue across the textile and fashion value chain and strengthening collaboration between education, industry and innovation stakeholders at European level.



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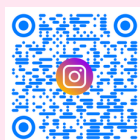
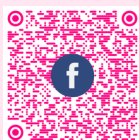


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
